

### Quondam Travel Scholarship Guidelines

1. Members of the current Sixth Form and Quondam members aged 25 and below, are eligible to apply for the Quondam Travel Scholarship. You can only be awarded the scholarship once.
2. The scholarship aims to help those who are in education or in unpaid or poorly paid employment, who wish to broaden their education and experience by travelling abroad.
3. The scholarship is now £1,000. Preference is given to applications involving elements of education or service to others.
4. Applications must include the following information at a minimum:
  - Full name
  - Date of birth
  - Email address
  - Telephone number
  - If you are a current Sixth Former – What are your plans for when you leave school? Are you planning a GAP year or to go straight on to Higher Education? What do you intend to study?
  - If you are a member of Quondam – What have you done since leaving school as far as Higher Education, work experience and/or work is concerned?
  - Where do you intend to travel?
  - For how long do you intend your travel to last?
  - What is the purpose of your travel? What benefits will you gain from the travel?
  - What benefits will others gain from your travel? (This is in the sense of help you might give to a project, teaching abroad, conservation work etc.)
  - What difference will winning the scholarship make to your travel?
  - How will you travel to and from your destination?
  - Name the airline or rail company you will use, and give the cost of your return tickets.
  - What are the costs you will have when staying at your destination?
5. Applications will be considered at a committee meeting of Quondam once a year, usually held in May.
6. Final applicants may be contacted by email or telephone. If for any reason a winner cannot travel, the Committee reserves the right to decide if or how to allocate the Fund award.
7. Quondam regrets that they may not be able to consider applications submitted after the deadline.
8. An acknowledgement on receipt of the entry will be sent to the applicant by email.
9. All entries should be sent directly to [quondam@fhs-nw1.org.uk](mailto:quondam@fhs-nw1.org.uk) with the subject line "Quondam Travel Scholarship Entry".

10. Successful applicants will be required to present a full report of their time abroad when they return. A maximum of 600 words with some illustrative photographs is to be emailed to [quondam@fhs-nw1.org.uk](mailto:quondam@fhs-nw1.org.uk) for publication in the Quondam Magazine.
11. The winner will be expected to give a talk during a Sixth Form lecture or whole school assembly to demonstrate the use of the award and encourage girls to enter.
